

Contacting School


The school office is open from 8.30am.

Learning Makaton

13 members of staff have started learning how to use Makaton. Makaton is a unique communication programme that uses symbols (pictures), signs (gestures) and speech to enable people to communicate. It supports the development of essential communication skills such as attention and listening, comprehension, memory, recall and organisation of language and expression.
