

PE Non-negotiables

- Clear objectives should be set using subject specific vocabulary
- Lessons should build on pupils' existing learning
- Teaching environment should always be a safe space for learning
- All lessons should be engaging, stimulating, inspirational and interactive
- Praise and encouragement should be given throughout
- Rewards will be given frequently as appropriate
- Children should be given verbal feedback throughout and rewarded
- Equipment and resources should be looked after respectfully
- Careful use of open ended questions should be used to move learning on
- Children should feel comfortable with making mistakes and misconceptions should be addressed at the time
- Lessons should be concluded by probing questioning to check for understanding and share demonstration of skills
- Self assessment and peer assessment are strategies used frequently in lessons
- Verbal feedback is given, next steps are identified

Children are expected to:

- put in maximum effort at all times
- be attentive and listen carefully
- respect and value the ideas and opinions of others
- treat equipment and resources with respect
- ask relevant questions and be analytical thinkers
- take responsibility for their own learning and behaviour
